**6 pm – Non Public Session**

*Tad moved, seconded by Clarence to go into non public session under RSA 91-A: 3, II, (a). Voted yes 5-0.*

On returning to public session, *Tad moved, seconded by Jack to seal the minutes. Voted yes 5-0.*

Present were Loring Webster, Ann Somers, Helen Ballou, Dennis Skey and Hattie Bernstein.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Grove**

**Loring Webster** said the public toilets at the grove are a problem. They either need to change vendors or have them serviced more often.

**Karl** said non residents are parking in the Grove parking lot and asking members to come in with them as guests.

**Nashua Telegraph**

**Darrell** said there was a disparaging statement in the comments of a Nashua Telegraph article about Rena. He said these types of comments need to stop.
