# Minutes Board of Selectmen Monday, July 18, 2011

Selectmen Tad Putney, Clarence Farwell, Jack Flanagan, Darrell Philpot and Karl Dowling were present.

### 6 pm – Non Public Session

Tad moved, seconded by Clarence to go into non public session under RSA 91-A: 3, II, (a). Voted yes 5-0.

On returning to public session, Tad moved, seconded by Jack to seal the minutes. Voted yes 5-0.

Present were Loring Webster, Ann Somers, Helen Ballou, Dennis Skey and Hattie Bernstein.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### **Grove**

**Loring Webster** said the public toilets at the grove are a problem. They either need to change vendors or have them serviced more often.

**Karl** said non residents are parking in the Grove parking lot and asking members to come in with them as guests.
