- The 2019 budget was discussed. We will be trying to get the breathing air compressor out of this year's budget. The 2020 budget was talked about. We will be putting in for a new fire truck. We have an aging fleet with the average age being 25 years old.
- Personnel was discussed and two people are moving away. We will be putting on some classes for officer training. We will post the Lt. job after the training. Some new classes will be looked at for training.
- We have finished West Hill water hole and the Cleveland Hill water hole. We will be finishing up Laurelcree and Blueberry water holes this week. We will be finishing up Old Milford Rd. water hole and Mountain Rd. this week. Averill Rd. and South Spaulding water holes will be paved this year.
- Bingham's cistern is unchanged.
- Lee Lemoine has ordered the new parts to replace the 50 year old system we have for the fire horn. This will stop horn from sticking.
- We are waiting for one more price to come in on the painting, before picking a painting contractor.
- Saybrooke has pumped all three tanks downstairs for washing our gear. There was a lot of sludge in the bottom of boiler. We are washing our gear more to prevent cancer.
- Signing of bills.
