Plowing of Snow into Roadways

To promote the safe and orderly passage of the motoring public on the Town's roads, free from obstructions and obstacles created by the removal or depositing of snow, the Town of Brookline hereby adopted the following ordinance on February 9, 2009.

Pursuant to RSA 236:20, RSA 47:17, VII, and RSA 41:11, it shall be unlawful to plow, snow blow or shovel snow across any and all Town roads, including Class V and VI, or to deposit snow within the traveled portion of Town Roads.

Definitions:

<u>Across Town Roads</u> – shall mean pushing snow from one side to the other where snow would be deposited within the right-of-way of any road.

<u>Traveled Portion</u> – shall mean any part of the roadway in which vehicles would travel or within the shoulders of said roadway.

Any person who violates the provisions of the Snow Plowing Ordinance shall be guilty of a violation, subject to a \$100 fine. Subsequent offenses shall be subject to a fine of up to \$500.
