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Minutes Selectboard Monday July 18, 2016

Selectboard members present: Darrell Philpot, John Carr and Tom Humphreys along with Town Administrator Tad Putney.

Also present: Ann Somers and Finance Committee Member Linda Chomiak

6:30 PM Darrell opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Input

John expressed thanks to the Brookline Fire Department and all who participated in the Annual Rib & Chicken BBQ and Muster and thanked Tom for judging many of the events. John also expressed that Brookline shares in mourning the loss of our fellow police officers recently gunned down in the United States and hopes that law and order will quickly be restored. Tad spoke with Chief Quigley before the meeting who wanted to relay that the Brookline Police Department has received an outpouring of cards, gifts and food from the community, expressing gratitude and appreciation for their service and sacrifice. Darrell expressed his appreciation for participating in the Stone House Estates neighborhood initiative to collectively bid out propane by volume.

Minutes

John moved, seconded by Tom to approve the public session minutes of July 5th, Voted Yes 3-0. Tom moved, seconded by John to approve the non-public session minutes of July 5th - 2 sets, Voted Yes 3-0.

Warrants

The Selectboard signed Warrant #29 in the amount of \$2,481,745.86 and Payrolls of \$50,133.29 and \$8,771.88.

Update on the Pending Transportation Alternative Program Grant

Tad stated that it is time to start the application for the next round of sidewalk grants. There is \$5,000,000 available across the state; 56 letters of intent were submitted statewide, including four in our NRPC region.

Discuss Issuance of Hunting & Fishing Licenses by Town Clerk

Tad relayed that Patti continues to try to provide additional services at the Town Clerk's office. This past year she added local boat registrations, which a number of people have taken advantage of. She is currently pursuing the ability to provide hunting & fishing licensing as well and is closing the office at noon on Wednesday of this week so that she and Grace can attend a training session to start the process.

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Discuss Draft of 2015 Audit

Tad reviewed as memo with notable changes and audit findings. There is one notable change in the audit from last year and is a direct result of a new GASB Rule (No. 68) requiring each town to add a liability for its portion of the unfunded New Hampshire Retirement System. This is beyond the Town's control, but results in a notable change in the Town's "net position" from 2014 to 2015. The net pension liability as of December 31, 2015 was \$1,933,677, which is more than the year-over-year change in net position.

The auditor has recommended four items:

- General Ledger Budget Monthly budget reports for both revenues and expenses have historically been generated from Excel. Recommended we generate them out of Quickbooks, which will be more efficient as most of the figures are already in Quickbooks and it will avoid the chance of "re-keying" errors.
- Capital Asset Policy Recommended we adopt a Capital Asset Policy, including setting a threshold amount at which an item is classified a "capital asset", defining asset class types and establishing useful lives.
- Segregation of Library Duties Currently the library treasurer is responsible for making deposits, posting activity to the general ledger, performing monthly reconciliations and is a signer on the account. Recommended a second individual be responsible for maintaining the general ledger.
- Trust Funds In 2015 the trustees voted to require a co-signer on all checks and named the Town Administrator given general availability. Recommended for segregation of duties that the co-signers be limited to two trustees.

All of the recommendations are being pursued and can be achieved by the end of 2016.

No Wake Zone

Tad received a call from the Marine Patrol Captain responding to an inquiry about establishing a "no wake zone" at the boat launch. The process requires a petition signed by 25 people be submitted to the Marine Patrol and then they would hold a public hearing.

7:00 pm – Public Hearing re Transfer Station Fee Schedule

Darrell opened the Public Hearing. At 7:02, following no input from members of the public, *Tom moved, seconded by John, to close the Public Hearing. Voted Yes 3-0.*

Tom moved, seconded by John, to adopt the Transfer Station Fee Schedule as proposed. Voted 3-0.

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Economic Revitalization Zone(s) (ERZ)

The Board reviewed and supported the application for the ERZ designations to include 45 parcels across five zones. The application will be signed at the next Selectboard meeting and will included tonight's meeting minutes.
