Minutes Selectboard Monday, November 21, 2016

Selectboard members present: John Carr, Karl Dowling, Brendan Denehy and Tom Humphreys along with Town Administrator Tad Putney.

Also present: Jim Tracey, Jesse Rene, Evelyn Maghakian, Ken Hang and Kim Gagnon.

6:30 pm John opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Input

Brendan acknowledged **John's** State of NH win in the House of Representatives. **Tom** announced that the Fire Department and Afterschool Program are working together to provide Thanksgiving Baskets to Brookline families in need.

Approve Minutes

Brendan moved, seconded by Karl, to approve the public minutes from the November 7th meeting; Voted Yes 4-0.

Sign Warrants for Payment

The **Board** signed Warrant #47 in the amount of \$165,473.11, payrolls of \$53,566.12 and \$1,301.57, and annual stipends for elected officials of \$20,808.32. The revised amount of \$39,432.13 on Warrant #35 was reviewed and approved by the **Board**.

Update on Transportation Alternative Program

Tad stated that rebids are due by Friday December 9th for construction on the sidewalk project due to begin in the spring.

Update on Hazardous Mitigation Plan

Tad stated that the Nashua Regional Planning Commission and department heads are working on a Hazardous Mitigation Plan with public meetings set for December 13th, January 10th and February 14th at 10am in the Town Hall meeting room. The Plan needs to be updated every five years and is required for the Town to be eligible for FEMA aid.

Review Bids and Approve Printer for Town Report

After reviewing the bids, Tad recommended renewing with Country Press since they included more detailed work in their bid and the town was happy with last years production. Karl moved, seconded by Tom to accept the Country Press bid of \$1,403 for the printing of the 2016 town report; Voted Yes 4-0.

Review and Approve Capital Assets Policy

Tad stated that the auditors had suggested that we put in place a capital assets policy and they provided a sample template. Tad drafted a policy summary and reviewed it with the Board. Brendan moved, seconded by Karl to accept the Capital Assets Policy; Voted Yes 4-0.

Discuss Regulatory Policy Audit by the Nashua Planning Commission

Brendan stated that the Planning Board feels this would be a good investment. The Selectboard discussed options for funding the \$5,500 cost. Karl feels that it should be a Warrant Article at Town Meeting as opposed to a line item in the budget.

Discuss Health Insurance Approach for 2017

Tad reviewed the amounts full-time employees would receive if the Town covered the cost of increasing the portion of health insurance paid by employees from 15% to 20%. Tad noted we will have peer data on planned 2017 pay increases at the next meeting and both items can be reviewed together and a decision made. The Board agreed.

Approve 2017 Health Plan

Brendan moved, seconded by Karl, to authorize John to sign the 2017 Health Trust contract; Voted Yes 4-0.

Corey Hill Road Residents Re: Process for Making it a Town Road

Jim Tracey read a summary of why the residents of Corey Hill Road believe the road should become a town road and expressed concerns if it does not become public. Jim stated that the main concern for the residents is the cost and asked the Board to consider waiving some costs such as a full engineering plan for construction. John stated that we need to follow the process and work together with the main concern being limited cost and liability to the Town. Jim asked that the Board consider ways to help with the costs within the guidelines of the rules and regulations of the Town.

John moved, seconded by Brendan, to go into Non-Public Session under RSA 91-A:3 (c) Reputation (d) Land Acquisition and (e) Litigation; Voted Yes 4-0.

John moved, seconded by Karl, to come out of Non-Public Session and seal the minutes; Voted Yes 4-0.

Meetinghouse Hill Road

Tad stated that the owner had agreed to clean up the property and remove the safety hazard from the entrance to the building by November 15, 2016. **Tad** noted the structural hazard has been removed, but no clean-up on the property had occurred. **Brendan** asked that a follow up check be done by December 15, 2016.
