Minutes Selectboard Monday, May 21, 2018

Selectboard members present: Brendan Denehy (by phone), Tom Humphreys, Val Ogden, Eddie Arnold and Ron Olsen along with Town Administrator Tad Putney. Also present: Ann Somers, Kevin Visnaskas.

6:30pm Eddie opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Announce Hiring of the New Brookline Ambulance Director

The Board announced the hiring of Shawn Jackson as the new Ambulance Director.

Public Input

Brendan announced that the Memorial Day Ceremony will be held on Monday, May 28th at 9:30am on the Town Hall lawn. **Tad** said Police Chief Quigley recently presented commendations to Sergeant Keith Hervieux and Master Patrolman Robert Pelletier for recently responding to a suicidal subject who had a 12-gauge shotgun when they arrived. The Sergeant and Master Patrolman were able to talk the subject out of taking his own life.

Approve Minutes

Ron moved, seconded by Val, to approve the minutes from the Monday, May 7th and Tuesday, May 15th 2018 meetings as written; Roll Call Vote Yes 5-0.

Ron moved, seconded by Val, to approve four sets of non-public minutes from the Monday, May 7th 2018 meeting as written; Roll Call Vote Yes 5-0.

Ron moved, seconded by Val, to approve two sets of non-public minutes from the Tuesday, May 15th 2018 meeting as written; Roll Call Vote Yes 4-0; Tom abstained.

Sign Warrants

The Board signed Accounts Payable Warrant #21 in the amount of \$112,542.76, Payroll Warrant #22 in the amount of \$52,196.02 and Police Detail Warrant in the amount of \$950.00.

Appointments

The Board signed the appointment slip for Danielle Molinari as Alternate Library Trustee until the term expires on March 31, 2019.

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Old Business

Milfoil Treatment - Tad shared the highlights of the new herbicide treatment for milfoil approved by the EPA in early 2018. Based on information provided by the vendor, he explained it is a new mechanism of action, which allows for extended control as well as rapid uptake and impact to the milfoil. He also noted that there are no drinking water, swimming or fishing restrictions and it requires 200-400 times less product than the herbicide used in prior treatments.

Elderly Exemption - Tad said last week we received the 2017 elderly exemption information for other NH towns. He suggested we put together a potential peer group for review with the Board at the June 18th meeting prior to Peter Cook compiling the town-by-town data. The Board agreed.

Review and Discuss Cornerstone Chapel Rental Agreement

After a brief discussion, Val moved, seconded by Ron, to authorize Brendan to sign the Chapel rental agreement with Cornerstone Bible Church. Roll Call Vote Yes 4-0; Eddie abstained.

Review and Discuss Engineering Agreement for Bond Street Bridge

After a brief discussion, Ron moved, seconded by Val, to send the proposed engineering agreement between the Town and Hoyle, Tanner & Associates, Inc. to NHDOT for their review and approval; Roll Call Vote Yes 5-0.

Discuss 2018/2019 Melendy Pond Planning Committee Charter

Tad said a draft of the Melendy Pond Planning Committee Charter was posted on the website and sent to the Melendy Pond Authority members, along with the nine members on the 2017 Melendy Pond Evaluation Committee. Tad said he received two feedback emails and both had two similar suggestions. The first suggested on page one, second paragraph, second bullet, the phrasing be changed from "should" to "when" leases expire. The second suggestion involved a stipulation for the at-large members on the committee that they not be tenants of Melendy Pond or have an affiliation with a tenant. Kevin said most affected people are lease holders. The Board agreed to make the suggested changes to the charter. Tad clarified that the Melendy Pond Authority oversees the Melendy Pond property and the Melendy Pond Association is made up of, and oversees the needs of, the Melendy Pond Planning Committee Charter with the noted changes on pages 1 and 2; Roll Call Vote Yes 5-0.

Discuss Site Visit to Melendy Pond and Hood Road

The Board set a site visit for 5pm on Monday, June 18, 2018 starting at Melendy Pond.

Sign Eagle Scout Recognition Letter

The Board signed a letter recognizing and congratulating Bennett Andrew Decoteau for advancing to Eagle Scout, the highest rank awarded by the Boy Scouts of America.

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Selectboard Task List
