Minutes Selecthoard Monday, July 7, 2014

Selectboard members Darrell Philpot, Susan Adams, Karl Dowling, John Carr and Brendan Denehy were present along with Town Administrator Tad Putney. Approximately 30 people were in attendance.

Darrell opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Sidewalk

Ann Somers said she appreciated the trimming of the trees along the sidewalk from Meetinghouse Hill Road to the center of town. Tad noted that Jerry Farwell trimmed them before the fireworks.

Fireworks

Forrest Milkowski said the fireworks were very nice but didn't feel they were as high as in the past.

Minutes

John moved, seconded by Sue to approve the public session minutes of June 23rd. Voted yes 5-0. Karl moved, seconded by Brendan to approve the 4 sets of non-public session minutes of June 23rd. Voted yes 5-0.

Warrants

The Selectboard signed warrant #27 in the amount of \$2,763,364.58 and payrolls in the amounts of \$46,357.03 and \$2,900.

Fire – June 24th

Darrell read proclamations honoring the service and bravery of David Flannery, Phil Soletsky and Jean Paul Royea as the first responders to a fully involved residential structure on June 24th who located and rescued an unconscious individual in the basement of the structure using a thermal imaging camera.

Letters of appreciation were sent to the selectmen of the towns of Hollis, Milford Amherst, Mason, Wilton and Townsend and Pepperell MA for their assistance to Brookline and the Wilson family.

The Selectboard sent a letter to Walmart for a generous donation of clothing for each member of the Wilson family.

Treasurer

Darrell read a letter of resignation from Bob Rochford as treasurer effective September 30th.

Library

Ann Somers sent an email that a library patron observed major limbs falling from a maple tree at the entrance of the library. She expressed concern of safety as there are at least two dead limbs still on the tree. **Darrell** said we need to determine whether the trees belong to the town or the Shutt's.

Gas Pipeline

Drew Keller and Peter Smith of Beaver Brook Association were present to discuss alternate routes for the proposed gas pipeline from New York to Dracut MA. The original plan is to go through Beaver Brook conservation land. Drew said they have a legal responsibility to take action to protect their properties which have conservation easements. Beaver Brook hired an engineering firm to come up with alternate routes for the pipeline. Alternate routes are along Rte. 122 in Hollis, Rte. 13 from Townsend MA through Brookline and a third route that crosses Oak Hill Road, travels along Rte. 130 toward Cross Road and then goes east of Route 130 and old Milford Road. He said it's a regional issue, not a Brookline vs. Hollis issue. Brendan asked why it can't be more easterly. Drew said they were trying to avoid conservation land and the rail trail. Darrell asked what they expect from the Selectboard. Drew said they would like the Board's preferred route. Darrell asked what the compelling reason there is to endorse the pipeline coming through Brookline. Forrest Milkowski said the primary objective is to protect conservation land. He said if it's coming through Brookline, we should pick a route that least effects property. **Keith Thompson** said he's opposed to it under any circumstances. He said if we don't speak up they'll think we're for it and asked that we get more input from the residents. Gale Taylor asked if it would affect the cemetery on Rte. 13. Tad said he didn't know. Gale said we need a marketing plan. The first thing we should do is write a letter that we're opposed to it coming through Brookline. Jordan Bailey, member of the conservation commission and former wildlife biologist said this could change the forests ecologically. Lynn Clark of Pepperell said they have formed a coalition opposing the project. **Buddy Dougherty** asked if it's the Selectboard's responsibility to notify the residents along the proposed alternate routes. It was agreed to send a letter in opposition of the pipeline through Brookline and schedule a public hearing on July 21st so more people can attend.

This discussion lasted over 2 hours.

Ambulance/Emergency Management Director

Tad presented a draft of potential steps in search for a successor to Wes starting with one on one sessions this month with current ambulance attendants, meeting with Chief Towne and Sandy in Hollis regarding their merger of the ambulance and fire departments and ending with using MRI for external recruitment between September and November. A vote to change the structure of the fire department would have to take place at a town meeting (not a special meeting) and wouldn't become effective until the following year.

Non Public Session

Darrell moved, seconded by John to go into non public session under RSA 91-A: 3, II (e) litigation and (a) personnel. Voted yes 5-0.

On returning to public session Darrell moved, seconded by Karl to seal the minutes. Voted yes 5-0.
