Minutes Selectboard Monday, September 29, 2014

Selectboard members Darrell Philpot, Susan Adams, John Carr and Brendan Denehy were present along with Town Administrator Tad Putney.

Also present was Ann Somers.

Darrell opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Ann asked about the status of filling the position of Ambulance/Emergency Management Director. **Darrell** said the job was posted, the Board has conducted interviews and is in the process of doing background checks.

Minutes

Brendan moved, seconded by John to approve the public session minutes of September 15th. Voted yes 3-0; Darrell abstained.

John moved, seconded by Sue to approve the 2 sets of non public session minutes of September 15th. Voted yes 3-0; Darrell abstained.

Sue moved, seconded by Brendan to approve the non public session minutes of September 25th. Voted yes 4-0.

Warrants

The Selectboard signed warrant # 39 in the amount of \$80,045.32 and payrolls in the amount of \$42,631.61 and \$1,160.

Conservation Commission

The Selectboard signed an appointment form for Tom Rogers as Alternate Member of the Conservation Commission until March 31, 2016.

Overseer of Public Welfare

Tad said the vacancy was posted. He received one call and will meet with her and Ann Webb. He said the food pantry is open on Saturdays from 10 am to noon for drop offs.

Wildwood Drive - Canney Hill Estates

On the recommendation of the planning board and town engineer Dennis LaBombard Sue moved, seconded by Brendan to approve a performance guarantee in the amount of \$68,169 for the completion of Phase 3 of Wildwood Drive. Voted yes 4-0.

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Annex

Tad said the annex is complete and was under budget by \$3,900. The facilities committee will meet tomorrow night to discuss a dehumidifier for the building.

TE Sidewalk Project

Tad said the sidewalk project is complete and was under budget by about \$43,000.

Town Hall

Tad said the town hall will be power washed this weekend and painting will begin next week.

Warrant Article Request

Webster Selectman Bruce Johnson is asking all NH towns and cities to include a warrant article at town meeting for the state to provide a comprehensive meaningful system of funding for State Education needs. **Darrell** said that it's okay but we need to tell the state where to cut in order to get more money for education. The Board will discuss it again when the full Board is present.

Erich Hahn – H-76

Erich Hahn was present to get clarification on his property (H-76). There was an approved subdivision of 4 lots in 1962 (Grogan) which predated zoning. A house was built on one lot many years ago and Erich built a house on one lot. Total acreage was about 18 acres. Erich feels he has two lots plus the large back lot. At some point Erich said the town merged the lots into one lot. The Board felt Erich needs to meet with the planning board. He will meet with Valerie and Tad to review the situation and determine next steps.

Gas Pipeline Coalition

Tad said the proposed pipeline is not going through Brookline according to Kinder Morgan's pre-filing maps. He said the Coalition meets every other Monday and feels it would be good to continue going to the meetings. The Board agreed as long as it doesn't interfere with Tad's town duties.

Complaint - Route 13

A complaint came in about the property on Route 13 with all the cars and asked what the selectboard is doing about it. **Darrell** said the town is taking appropriate action on the matter.

State of NH, Dept. of Safety

We received a letter from the Division of Emergency Services and Communications that effective October 15, 2014, the Division of Emergency Services and Communications (DESC) will be discontinuing the Emergency Stand-Alone (ESA) functionality for isolated phone service for the entire state. **Tad** will check with Wes on what effect this has on Brookline, if any.

Planning Board

The planning board will hold a public hearing on Thursday, October 16th to consider amendments to the Subdivision Regulation regarding Driveway Regulations and Excavation Site Plan Review Regulations.

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Apportionment Committee

Sue said the next apportionment committee meeting will be at the town hall this Thursday at 6:30 pm to work on a formula.

Non Public Session

Darrell moved, seconded by John to go into non public session under RSA 91-A, 3 (a) personnel. Voted yes 4-0.

On returning to public session Darrell moved, seconded by John to seal the minutes. Voted yes 4-0.

Meeting adjourned at 9:15 pm.
