Minutes Selectboard Monday, October 27, 2014

Selectboard members Susan Adams, John Carr and Brendan Denehy were present along with Town Administrator Tad Putney.

Also present were Ann Somers and Brian Rater.

Sue opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### Minutes

Brendan moved, seconded by John to approve the public session minutes of October 13<sup>th</sup>. Voted yes 3-0.

John moved, seconded by Brendan to approve the three sets of non public session minutes of October 13<sup>th</sup> and minutes of October 23<sup>rd</sup>. Voted yes 3-0.

#### <u>Warrants</u>

The Selectboard signed Warrant # 43 in the amount of \$220,786.66 and payrolls in the amount of \$42.880.89 and \$380.

#### Wildwood Drive

On the recommendation of the road agent and planning board, Brendan moved, seconded by John to accept Phase Two of Wildwood Drive and convert the bond to a maintenance bond in the amount of \$34,650 until the summer of 2016. Voted ves 3-0.

#### Tennessee Gas Pipeline

Kinder Morgan will be hosting an "open house" on the gas pipeline will be held on November 18<sup>th</sup> from 6 to 8 pm at the Hollis-Brookline High School.

#### Police Dept.

John moved, seconded by Brendan to appoint Nicholas Lavoie as a full time police officer. Voted yes 3-0. Nick has been a part time officer since October 2012.

#### **Police Contract**

Tad presented the Police Union Contract for the Selectboard's signatures. Tad, Sue and John negotiated with the union representatives for a new contract. The present contract expired December 31, 2011. The new contract will take be effective from June 1, 2015 to December 31, 2017. Because this has to be voted at town meeting, the contract couldn't become effective on January 1<sup>st</sup>. All police officers will move to the same health insurance plan as the town's non-union employees. As of June 1, 2015 the

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employees will contribute 15% toward health insurance and 20% starting January 1, 2017. There are also increases in wages.

#### Mexican Restaurant

**Rebecca Perez** was present to request a letter of support for a liquor license for a Mexican restaurant at 199 Route 13. *Brendan moved*, seconded by John to authorize Sue to sign the letter to the State recommending they issue a liquor license. Voted yes 3-0.

#### **Food Pantry**

**Sue** said the food pantry is in need of all types of donations with the holidays coming soon. The food pantry is now located in the lower town hall and is open from 10 am to noon on Saturdays for donations.

#### Tax Rate

Tad said he hopes to have a tax rate this week.

#### 2015 Proposed Budgets

Finance Committee members Brian Rater and Linda Chomiak were present.

<u>Communications</u> – Proposed budget is \$109,980.

Legal – Proposed budget is \$30,000.

Executive – Proposed budget is \$204,201.

<u>Planning & Zoning – Proposed budget is \$61,047.</u>

Sanitation - Proposed budget is \$269,951. SRLD will set their budget in December.

Conservation Commission – Jay Chrystal presented a proposed budget of \$8,023.

#### Fire Dept.

Charlie Corey, Dave Santuccio and Dave Flannery were present. Charlie asked that the warrant article for a full time fire chief show the annualized salary and benefits separately so residents will also know the full year costs. Tad said he would check on the wording. The warrant articles have to be reviewed by town counsel and the DRA.

#### **Ghost Train Rail Trail Race**

Tad said there were 250 runners that ran the 100 mile race. He said the conservation commission expects to receive about \$5,500 for their participation. The funds will be used for trail maintenance and improvements.

#### Non Public Session

Sue moved, seconded by John to go into non public session under RSA 91-A: 3 (a) personnel and (e) litigation. Voted yes 3-0.

On returning to public session Sue moved, seconded by John to seal the minutes. Voted yes 3-0.
