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Minutes Selectboard Monday, June 10, 2013

Selectboard members Darrell Philpot, Karl Dowling, John Carr, Susan Adams and Brendan Denehy were present along with Town Administrator Tad Putney.

Also present were Linda Chomiak, Ann Somers and Loring Webster.

Minutes

Sue moved, seconded by Brendan to approve the public session minutes of May 28th. Voted yes 5-0. John moved, seconded by Sue to approve the 4 sets of non public session minutes of May 28th. Voted yes 5-0.

Tad noted that we paid Sequoya early to get a 2% discount. The Selectboard said they were okay with sending out a check before a meeting to get a discount or avoid late fees.

Library Elevator

Sue said she noticed they were working on the library elevator. Tad said they hope to have it operational by the end of the week.

Budget

The Selectboard reviewed the disbursements and revenues through May.

NH Retirement System

A meeting is scheduled for June 25th from 6 to 8 pm between representatives from the towns of Brookline and Hollis, school governing bodies, budget committees and business administrators to understand and address concerns relating to the increases in the contributions to the NHRS. The meeting will be held at the Lawrence Barn in Hollis. **Brendan** said he is planning to attend.

Rental Checklist

The Selectboard reviewed the revised checklist to be completed after a town building is used and approved the revision.

Sue left the meeting at this point.

Groundwater Monitoring

Tad said ChemServe is willing to do a 3 year contract for monitoring the wells at the transfer station at the same price of \$1,520.16 yearly. **Karl** said the other two bidders weren't offered the same option of a three year contract. **Linda** suggested we request a multi year contract to the others. The Selectboard said for Tad to do what's most efficient.

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Town Hall Renovations

The Selectboard reviewed the Invitation to Bid packet for renovations to the lower town hall. Tad said the Invitation to Bid will be in the Brookliner, Hollis/Brookline Journal, Milford Cabinet, Bedford Journal and Merrimack Journal. Bidders have until July 8 to submit their bids. He said the plan is for the Selectboard to open the bids on July 8th and turn the bids over to the facilities committee to review and make a recommendation to the Selectboard at their meeting on July 22nd. *John moved, seconded by Brendan to accept the Invitation to Bid packet. Voted yes 4-0.*

Cash Receipts Policy

The Selectboard approved and signed the Cash Receipts Policy as drafted.

Class VI Roads

<u>Pierce Lane</u> – Tad said a portion of Pierce Lane (located on the Annex property) was discontinued in 1966.

<u>Mathews Road</u> – Tad said an article to discontinue Mathews Road in the 1982 warrant was defeated. He said the end of the road is blocked off by a chain which is not permitted by RSA 231:21-a unless it is unlocked. **Brendan** said the chain is removed in the winter for snowmobiling.

<u>Spaulding Brook Road</u> – Tad said an article in 1973 to discontinue Spaulding Brook Road was passed over at town meeting. He said Spaulding Brook Road is blocked by large boulders which do not permit passage for a car. The Board directed Tad to make sure the boulders are moved so the road is passable per the RSAs.

Historical Society

Linda said the Historical Society did a great job on the spaghetti supper last Saturday.

Revaluation

Tad said the new assessments on properties should be in the mail to owners next month. People with questions can schedule an appointment with Avitar Associates to review their assessment cards.

July 4th - Fireworks

Tad said the fireworks were scheduled for July 5th but that day is a holiday for Camp Tevya. He said they are looking at another date.

Non Public Session

Darrell moved, seconded by Karl to go into non public session under RSA 91-A: 3, II (a) litigation and (c) reputation. Voted yes 4-0.

On returning to public session Darrell moved, seconded by Brendan to seal the minutes. Voted yes 4-0.
