For residents new to Brookline and current residents who will be 18 by Election Day who are not yet Registered to Vote in Brookline.

Students who are now 17, **but will be 18 before or on the date of an election** can fill out voter registration forms. For those who will be 18 by November 3, 2020 you can register NOW.

REGISTERING IN PERSON: Go in person to the Brookline Town Clerk's Office during regular business hours. You will fill out the voter registration form and bring proof of Age, identity, domicile and citizenship. You may also register at the session of the Supervisors of the Checklist. Meeting date is below.

NEW--In addition—a supervisor will be available on the first floor of the Town Hall on 10/7, 10/14, and 10,21/2020 from 5PM-7 PM. to take applications.

REGISTERING ABSENTEE (BY MAIL): You may request absentee voter registration forms and instructions from the Brookline Town Clerk before requesting an absentee ballot. You mail the application and required documents back to the Brookline Town Clerk.

The Supervisors of the Checklist must review and approve your application. They are required to meet on a date 6 to 13 days before the November 3, 2020 general election. Meeting date is below.

Unless the supervisors hold voluntary sessions before then, the supervisors will review your application at that meeting. You are registered to vote when the supervisors approve the application. If you request an absentee ballot before you are registered, the clerk will send you both your absentee ballot and your absentee voter registration forms and instructions.

You may also register at the polls on the day of the election. Due to COVID-19 we recommend that you register as soon as possible --either at the Town Hall, at a supervisor sessions, or by mail **Register early to avoid standing in line on the day of election.. Social distancing limits the number of people who can be registered at the same time.**
